

Departure Route Description

- All **rwys**: Maintain **5000** or as assigned.
- Rwy 03**: Climb hdg **028°** for vectors.
- Rwy 13**: Climb hdg **125°** for vectors.
- Rwy 21**: Climb hdg **208°** for vectors.
- Rwy 31**: Climb hdg **305°** for vectors.

Communication Failure

- On recognition of communication failure 10 minutes or less after take-off and in IFR weather conditions proceed as follows:
1. Select transponder code 7600;

2. Upon reaching assigned altitude proceed directly on course;

3. Maintain last assigned altitude for 10 minutes after take-off, then;

4. Climb to flight planned altitude, except in the case of Trans Atlantic departures, climb to the altitude specified in the Oceanic Clearance.
- NOTE:** If communication failure occurs more than 10 minutes after take-off, comply with the appropriate procedure for communication failure enroute.
