

Departure Route Description

- All rws:** Maintain **5000** or flight planned altitude, whichever is lower. Expect radar vectors to filed/assigned route. Expect clearance to flight planned altitude/flight level within 10 minutes after departure.
- Rwy 06:** Climb hdg **058°** or as assigned by ATC for radar vectors.
- Rwy 24:** Climb hdg **238°** or as assigned by ATC for radar vectors.
- Rwy 15:** Climb hdg **148°** or as assigned by ATC for radar vectors.
- Rwy 33:** Climb hdg **328°** or as assigned by ATC for radar vectors.

Communication Failure

- On recognition of failure 10 minutes or less after take-off and in IFR weather conditions proceed as follows:
1. Select transponder code 7600;
 2. Upon reaching last assigned altitude proceed directly on course;
 3. Maintain last assigned altitude until 10 minutes after take-off, then;
 4. Climb to flight planned altitude.
- Note:** If communication failure occurs more than 10 minutes after take-off, comply with the appropriate procedure for communication failure enroute.

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
