

Departure Route Description

All rwys: Maintain **2000** or as assigned. Expect radar vectors to filed/assigned route and clearance to flight planned altitude/flight level 10 minutes after departure.

Rwy 08L: Requires a minimum climb gradient of **280** ft/NM to **500**. Climb hdg **083°** to **1000**. Then climbing RIGHT turn hdg **145°** or as assigned by ATC.

Rwy 08R: Climb hdg **083°** to **1000**. Then climbing RIGHT turn hdg **145°** or as assigned by ATC.

Communication Failure

If no radio contact with Departure Control by published/assigned altitude, proceed as follows:

- 1. Select transponder code 7600;
- 2. Maintain last assigned altitude and turn direct to "YVR" VOR. Hold INBD **R-260**;
- 3. Proceed on course 5 minutes after selecting code 7600 and climb to flight planned altitude.
