

Departure Route Description

Unless otherwise assigned by ATC

- All rwys: Maintain 4000.
- Rwy 08: Climb hdg 077° to 4000. Expect radar vectors to assigned route.
- Rwy 18: Climb hdg 179° to 4000. Expect radar vectors to assigned route.
- Rwy 26: Climb hdg 257° to 4000. Expect radar vectors to assigned route.
- Rwy 36: Climb hdg 359° to 4000. Expect radar vectors to assigned route.

Communication Failure

On recognition of failure 10 minutes or less after take-off and IFR weather conditions, proceed as follows:

- 1. Select transponder code 7600;
- 2. Proceed directly on course 5 minutes after selecting 7600, then;
- 3. Climb to flight planned altitude.

NOTE: If communication failure occurs more than 10 minutes after take-off, comply with appropriate procedures for Communication Failure en-route.

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
