

Departure Route Description

- All rwys:** Maintain **4000** unless otherwise assigned by ATC. Expect clearance to flight planned altitude/flight level 10 minutes after departure.
- Rwy 08:** Climb hdg **075°**, or as assigned for vectors to assigned route.
- Rwy 14:** Climb hdg **138°**, or as assigned for vectors to assigned route.
- Rwy 26:** Climb hdg **255°** to **1600**. Then climbing LEFT turn hdg **190°**, or as assigned for vectors to assigned route.
- Rwy 32:** Climb hdg **318°**, or as assigned for vectors to assigned route.
- NOTE:** Refer to Noise Abatement Procedures for additional requirements.

Communication Failure

On recognition of a failure 10 minutes or less after take-off and in IFR weather conditions proceed as follows:

1. Select transponder code 7600;
2. Proceed on course;
3. Do not climb above last assigned altitude for 10 minutes after recognition of the failure (Transponder equipped aircraft 5 minutes), then;
4. Climb to flight planned altitude.

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
