

Departure Route Description

All rws: Maintain **3000** or as assigned. Expect radar vectors to filed/assigned route.
Expect clearance to flight planned altitude/flight level 10 minutes after departure.

Rwy 07: Climb hdg **070°** for vectors.

Rwy 12: Climb hdg **123°** for vectors.

Rwy 25: Climb hdg **250°** for vectors.

Rwy 30: Requires a minimum climb gradient of **210 ft/NM** to **1300**. Climb hdg **303°** for vectors.

Communication Failure

On recognition of failure 10 minutes or less after take-off and in IFR weather conditions proceed as follows:

- 1. Select transponder code 7600;
- 2. Proceed on course;
- 3. Do not climb above last assigned altitude for 10 minutes after recognition of the failure (Transponder equipped aircraft 5 minutes), then;
- 4. Climb to flight planned altitude.
