

Departure Route Description

All rws: Maintain **5000** or flight planned altitude, whichever is lower. Expect radar vectors to filed/assigned route. Expect clearance to flight planned altitude/flight level within 10 minutes after departure.

Rwy 06: Climb hdg **058°** or as assigned by ATC for radar vectors.

Rwy 24: Climb hdg **238°** or as assigned by ATC for radar vectors.

Rwy 15: Climb hdg **148°** or as assigned by ATC for radar vectors.

Rwy 33: Climb hdg **328°** or as assigned by ATC for radar vectors.

Communication Failure

On recognition of failure 10 minutes or less after take-off and in IFR weather conditions proceed as follows:

- 1. Select transponder code 7600;
- 2. Upon reaching last assigned altitude proceed directly on course;
- 3. Maintain last assigned altitude until 10 minutes after take-off, then;
- 4. Climb to flight planned altitude.

Note: If communication failure occurs more than 10 minutes after take-off, comply with the appropriate procedure for communication failure enroute.

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
